





No. 2 Phillips Screwdriver Tip Shown Actual Size







1-3/16" ALLEN SCREW - 12












Step 1

Assemble your unit on a carpeted floor or on the empty carton to avoid scratching your unit or the floor.


- NOTE: Start all of the SCREWS before tightening any of them.
- Fasten the ENDS (A) to the BRACES (D). Tighten eight 1-3/16" ALLEN SCREWS (2) using the ALLEN WRENCH (4).
- Square up the BRACES (D) to the ENDS (A).
- **▼** Completely tighten all of the SCREWS.



Step 2

Fasten the TOP (B) to the ENDS (A). Tighten four 1-3/16" ALLEN SCREWS (2) into the threaded inserts in the TOP using the ALLEN WRENCH (4).

- NOTE: Start all of the SCREWS (2) before tightening any of them.
- Fasten the BOTTOM (C) to the ENDS (A). Use four 1-1/8" SCREWS (3).
- \blacksquare NOTE: Do <u>not</u> overtighten the SCREWS (3).
- Carefully stand your unit upright.
- NOTE: Please read the back pages of the instruction booklet for important safety information.
- This completes assembly. Clean with your favorite furniture polish or a damp cloth. Wipe dry.
