

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
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No. 2 Phillips Screwdriver Tip Shown Actual Size



5 BLACK 1/2" PAN HEAD SCREW - 4






Part Identification




While not all parts are labeled, some of the parts will have a label or an inked letter on the edge to help distinguish similar parts from each other. Use this part identification to help identify similar parts.



- Assemble your unit on a carpeted floor or on the empty carton to avoid scratching your unit or the floor.
- NOTE: Do <u>not</u> completely tighten the SCREWS in this step.
- Fasten the BRACES (G and K) to the UPRIGHT (C). Use three BLACK 3/8" MACHINE SCREWS (4).




- NOTE: Do <u>not</u> completely tighten the SCREWS in this step.
- Fasten the TOP (D) to the ENDS (A and B) and UPRIGHT (C). Use six BLACK 1-7/16" TAPERED MACHINE SCREWS (3).







- Fasten the SHELVES (E) to the RIGHT END (A) and UPRIGHT (C). Use eight BLACK 1-7/16" TAPERED MACHINE SCREWS (3).
- Completely tighten all of the SCREWS in the metal frame.




Fasten the CROSS BRACE (H) to the RIGHT END (A) and UPRIGHT (C). Use four BLACK 1/2" PAN HEAD SCREWS (5).

Turn six LEVELERS (1) into the bottom edges of the ENDS (A and B) and UPRIGHT (C).

- **▼** To level your unit, turn the LEVELERS.
